

Travel information

By train

For all information on how to reach Leuven, please have a look at <u>this webpage</u>. From Brussels airport, we would recommend taking a train to Leuven, as they are frequent and quick (usually quicker than a taxi, due to traffic). The train station at the Airport is located on level -1 and can be easily reached by using the escalators or elevators.



Once you have arrived in Leuven, you will quickly notice that the city is rather small and that everything can easily be reached **on foot**. It is a 15-minute walk from Leuven station (Martelarenplein 16, Leuven) to the Maria Theresia College (Sint-Michielsstraat 13, Leuven): see directions or scan the QR-code.



If you don't feel like walking, you can also take **the bus**. A lot of buses run through the city center: Bus number 2 takes you to the Sint-Michielsstraat) (e.g.: <u>De Lijn</u>)

If you need a taxi, you can take one at the entrance of the Leuven railway station or book a taxi by telephone via +32 16 22 20 00 (Taxi Leuven) or +32 16 26 10 10 (Taxi Jenny). Please note that there are no Ubers in Leuven! If you are at the conference venue and need a taxi, please come and see us at the registration desk, and we will book one for you.

By car

Leuven is located at the junction of two motorways: the E40 and the E314. The 'P' signposts will guide you to the different car parks. An overview of the car parks in Leuven can be found <u>here</u>.

There is no parking at the conference venue. You can find the nearest public parking at Q-Park Heilig Hart (address: Naamsestraat 102, 3000 Leuven, Belgium). From here it is only a 6-minute walk (550m) to the conference venue: https://goo.gl/maps/iadY5JW78zP6JrWW7.

There is another public parking under the Monseigneur Ladeuzeplein, which is also a 6 min walk to the conference venue: https://goo.gl/maps/rVPf3XUxCUmJz36q9.

COVID-19 measures

General COVID-19 measures

As of March 23, we can organize the meeting in person with no restrictions.

A Covid-19 certificate is no longer needed to enter the congress venues. Face masks are no longer mandatory in public transport, in the congress venues and restaurants/bars/shops in the city. A Passenger Locator Form (PLF) is no longer needed within the EU.

Travelling to Belgium

The Passenger Locator Form (PFL) must be filled in *by everyone who, directly or indirectly, travels to Belgium* from a country OUTSIDE the European Union or Schengen area that is not on the white list (which you can find <u>here</u>), by train, bus, boat or plane. The PLF document can be found <u>here</u>) and must be filled in maximum 48h prior to your arrival in Belgium.

In all other cases, you may fill in the PLF, but it is not mandatory.

If you need to take a COVID-19 PCR test in Belgium, please find an overview of the test centers on the conference website: COVID-19 - CAISE 2022.

For a COVID certified antigen test, you can go to one of the pharmacies in the city center: e.g., Farma De Bond (Bondgenotenlaan 163), Apotheek Vandenbosch (Brusselsestraat 136), Multipharma 437 (Leopold Vanderkelenstraat 4).

Registration

Registration and Information Desk

The Registration and Information Desk is situated in room 00.03 of the Maria Theresiacollege (Sint-Michielsstraat 13, Leuven). Please follow the signage upon arrival at the venue.





When you arrive for the first time on the conference venue, then you can pick up your conference badge at the Registration and Information Desk. Please note that it can be quite busy at the desk on Monday morning and Wednesday morning. So, to avoid long queues, we strongly advise you to pick up your badge and conference bag in time.

Conference badges

Wi-Fi

We offer free Wi-Fi in all university buildings. The network to connect with is **campusroam**. Each participant will receive a **personal login name and password**. These personal login details can be found on the back of your name badge. Please note that these login details can only be used at one device at a time. Once you enter your login and password, you should be able to access the campusroam network.

Should you have an **eduroam**-account, you will be able to access the eduroam-network as well within the university buildings.

AUTOMATIC CONFIGURATION WITH THE CAT-TOOL

Should you experience any problems, we advise you to use the CAT-tool to automatically configure the wireless networks campusroam and eduroam.

Download the tool from <u>cat.eduroam.org</u> or scan the QR-code to the right. The tool does the complete configuration from scratch or adjusts existing configurations for pc, smartphone and tablet.



The campusroam-2.4 & eduroam-2.4 networks (for older devices) will not be configured with this tool. You will need to follow the manual configuration steps for these networks.






Conference party
